Sajha, led by Sandeep Bhakta, along with Kamal Patel, will open three Blaze Pizza locations in the Los Angeles area, the first of which is slated to launch in spring 2013. As the first Blaze Pizza franchisees, Sajha's executives have more than 12 years of QSR-sector experience operating successful nationwide franchises. Concepts within Sajha's portfolio include Cold Stone Creamery and Which Wich Sandwiches.

Blaze Pizza makes its own dough from scratch using a recipe created by Executive Chef Bradford Kent of Olio Pizzeria & Café, who developed the dough and recipes exclusively for the company. Blaze Pizza offers gluten-free dough and vegan cheese to accommodate pizza fans with specific dietary needs as well. The restaurant's menu also features signature salads, lemonades, beer & wine, and house-made S'more Pies for dessert.
